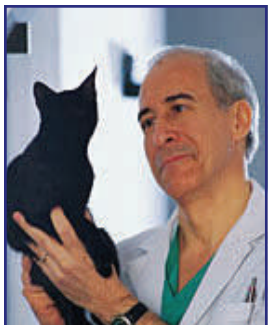

TIFF Funds Feline Research



Founded in 1995, The International Feline Foundation (TIFF), is a non-profit organization that supports research into medical problems affecting cats.

Studies applicable to all cats are encouraged, however, TIFF is also interested in projects that address problems unique to individual breeds.

The TIFF Board of Directors selects projects for funding based on a set of criteria, which includes scientific merit, value to cats, clinical relevancy, soundness of budget and humane considerations to any cats involved. TIFF makes funds available on a yearly basis for such studies.



Applicants may be faculty veterinarians, post-doctoral fellows, practicing veterinarians or veterinary students in an accredited veterinary school.
